


Legacy Landing Pages - WordPress Plugin


This article applies to:

You can display your Landing Page in your WordPress website. You can assign any domain name you own to the landing page. It will give the appearance that the page exists on your website.


1. Log in to your WordPress website
2. Click **Plugins**
3. Click **Add New**



4. Search for *Infusionsoft Landing Pages*
5. Click **Install Now** on the plugin listing page. Once installed, the WordPress plugin can be found under **Settings**.



6. Grab the URL of a landing page you've created in Infusionsoft



7. Paste the URL and add a Slug. The URL is what you copied from Infusionsoft. The Slug is the page name that you would like to use on your WordPress website. Just note that it can't use an existing page name you already have

published.
