


### Embed a public form

Embed your public form onto your website to make it easier to capture new leads directly into your CRM.


1. Go to Marketing > Forms



2. Make sure you are viewing Public forms



3. Click the **more** button at the far-right of the form name you want to embed and select "Copy code"



4. Click Copy code



5. Paste the code into your website builder's HTML



1. Hover over a new block and choose to add a new HTML element





3. Now, just update your page and view your embedded content



4. You may want to tweak the height and width attributes in the code to get your desired look. For example, I changed the height to be "900px" instead of "100%" in order to get rid of the scroll bar.




### Wix


1. Click Add



2. Scroll down and hover over the **More** option



3. Choose HTML iframe




4. Position the iframe on the page where you would like it



5. Click Enter Code




6. Select the **Code** radio button




7. Paste the code into the text box and click Apply



8. **Publish** your changes




9. You can tweak the size of the embedded content to better fit on the page. For example, you may want to stretch it downward until the scroll-bar is gone.




## Squarespace

Note that Squarespace requires a business plan in order to embed JavaScript or use iframes.

1. Click the + button to add a new element to the page



2. Choose the Code option




3. Delete the default code in the box, paste your embed code, then hit Apply.



# **Google Sites**

1. Insert an **Embed** block



2. Click Embed code
