

Using Siri to send a message (iOS only)

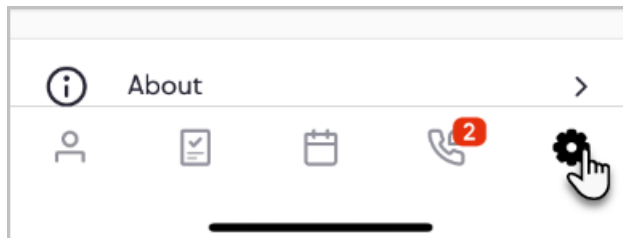
This article applies to:

On iPhone or iPad, you can use Siri to send messages to your contacts, giving you hands-free access to message your contacts. Now you can send messages hands-free while driving, working with your hands, or twenty feet off the ground on a ladder.

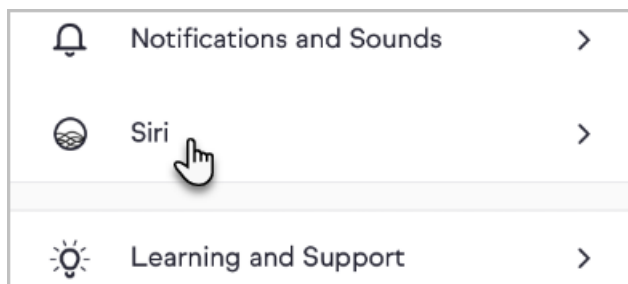
Enable Siri for Keap

To enable Siri, Keap must be allowed to access Hey Siri.

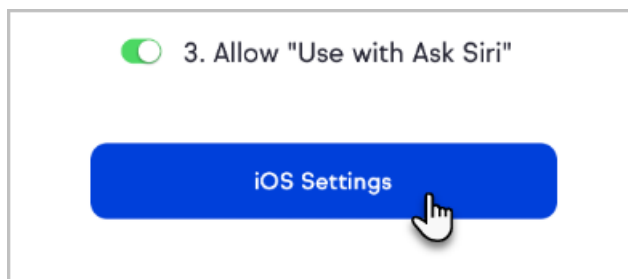
1. Open your app **Settings**



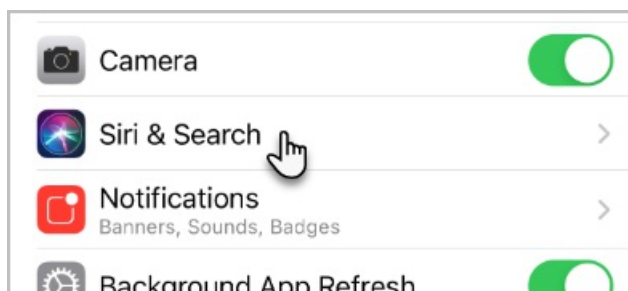
2. Tap **Siri**



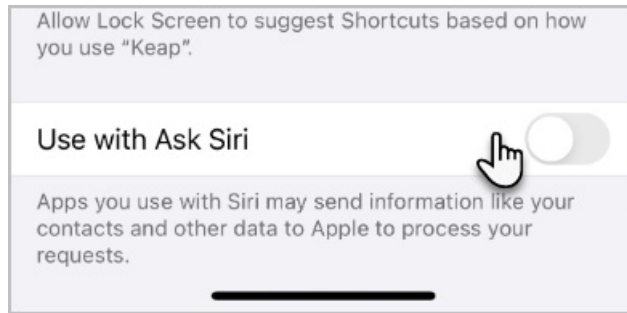
3. Tap the **iOS Settings** button



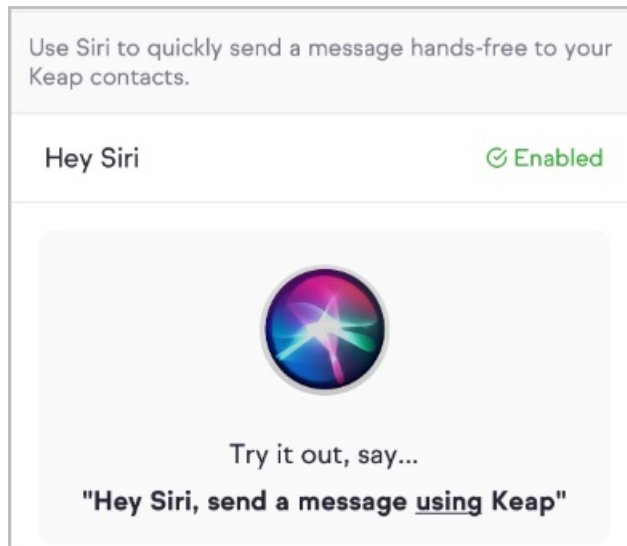
4. Tap **Siri & Search**



5. Toggle **Use with Ask Siri** to the on position

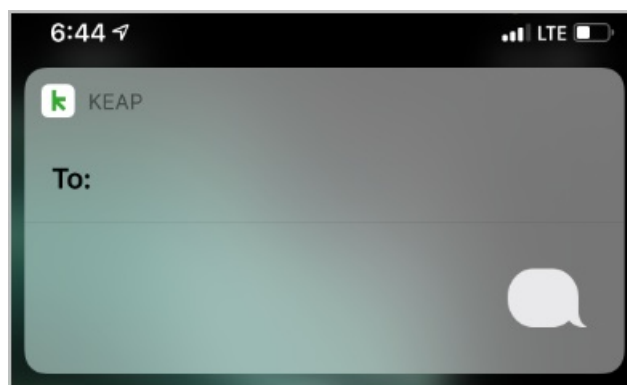


6. Switch back to your Keep app and you'll see a message on how you can use Siri

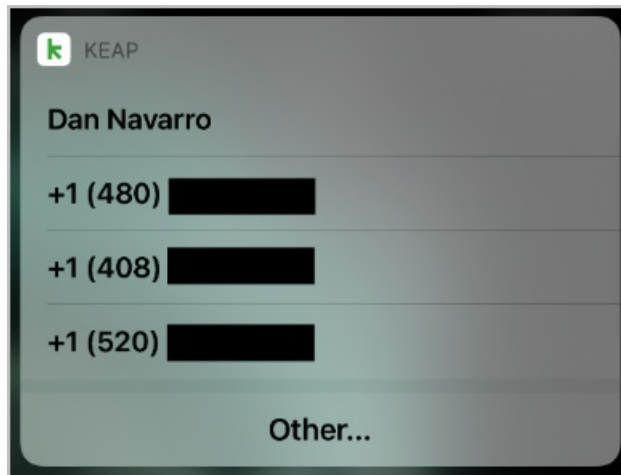


Send a Keap Business Line message with Siri

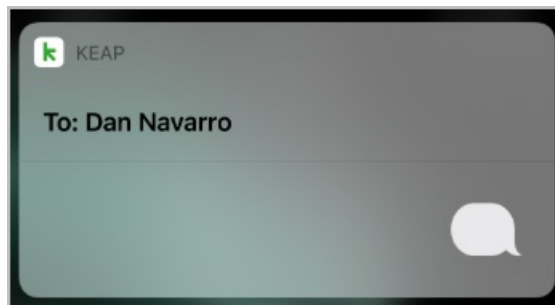
1. Say "Hey Siri, send a message using Keap"
2. Tell Siri who you would like to send a message to



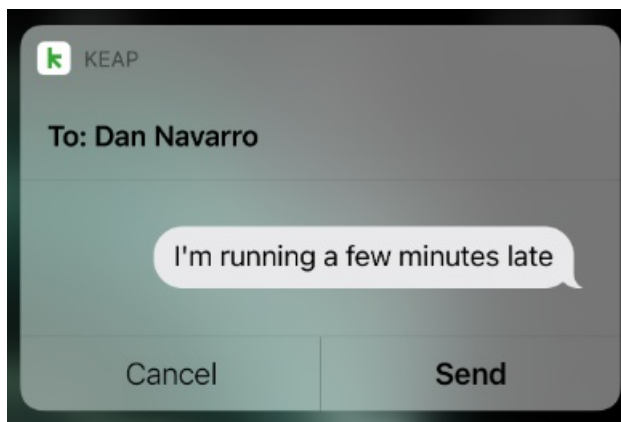
3. If your contact has multiple phone numbers, Siri will read and show you the available numbers



4. Siri will ask "what do you want to say?" and wait for your message



5. When you're finished, Siri will say "here is your message" and display the message



6. Siri will ask "are you ready to send it?" Say "send it" or tap the **Send** button to send your message using Keap Business Line.
