This features gives UK and AUS customers the ability to add a tax ID in the new Sales Settings to be saved and published on every invoice. Depending on the option chosen (UK VAT or AUS GST) the rest of the invoice will be formatted with the required fields including:

- UK VAT-Business' Tax ID Number, Billing date (Date Invoice was Issued), VAT per item, Legal Business Name
- AUS GST -Invoice must be called "Tax Invoice" Not just Invoice, ABN-Australian Business Number, Billing date (Date Invoice was Issued), GST per item, Subtext that says "Total Price includes GST", Legal Business Name
