

Solution Launchpad - referencing items via URL[Ⓜ]

This document outlines the items which will be included on an install if we find URLs pointing to them, within the content of items you are sharing with Solution Launchpad.

Supported items:

The following items, if referenced via URL, will be included in your install:

- [Appointment Types](#)
- [Public Forms](#)
- [Landing Pages](#)
- [Checkout Forms](#)
- Hosted files, such as file downloads or uploaded images used in your content

Behavior notes:

- Rest assured - URLs in your content pointing to a supported type will be automatically updated to point to the newly-installed item in the destination app.
 - Example: You are sharing an email template, which has a link to a landing page in it. Solution Launchpad will install the landing page in addition to the email template. The link in the newly installed email template in the destination will get updated automatically to the URL of the newly installed landing page.
- Only Keap-provided URLs / Platforms are supported. URLs pointing to 3rd-party resources are treated as text in your content.
- Items referenced via URL **must exist** in the **same tenant** as the item you are sharing via Solution Launchpad. If the URL points to a different app **or** a deleted item, the install process **will fail**.
- Do not enter a fake URL that “looks” like a Keap-provided URL, or the install process will fail. Example: *http://keap.page/not-a-real-app/not-a-real-page.html*
